BUDGET DEVELOPMENT POLICY

The Board of School Trustees believes that the development of a fiscally sound budget is among the most important of its duties.

The Board further believes that the understanding of, investment in, and ownership by a wide range of publics is important to the overall mission of the district. Participation in the budget development will allow the staff and others involved to gain a more complete understanding of the district's overall operation.

The Board maintains the prerogative to allocate certain funds so as to maintain the focus on the mission and annual goals of the district.

It is the intent of the Board through the implementation of this policy and regulations related to it, to offer employee groups, citizens and when appropriate, students the opportunity for a voice in the budget development process. It is also the intent of the Board to make participation in any and all of these opportunities voluntary and that any employee, employee group, citizen or group may choose not to participate in any or all of the component parts.
