CLOSED CAMPUS

Storey County School District will carry out the practice of district wide closed campuses. Pupils will be required to remain on school grounds from the time they arrive at school, until they complete their entire school day. Students in violation of this regulation will be considered truant per NRS 392.130, 392.140, 392.150, and 392.160

Exceptions may be granted to students who must leave because of illness or injury, or who are excused for medical appointments, or to individual students at the discretion of the principal because of special circumstances.

Student and staff parking lots, with the exception of the Virginia City Middle School, are not considered part of the school grounds for the purpose of this regulation, and students may not go to the parking lot during the school day, unless by special permission of the principal, or his designee.

The high school may, upon school board approval, have an open campus during lunchtime if appropriate guidelines are established. The open campus may also be denied at any time by the school board upon principal recommendation or other repeated reports of undesirable student activity during lunchtime.

For any group of teacher supervised students who may be leaving campus for related activities of physical education, theatre, history or other classroom instruction, the county park, Piper's Opera House and Virginia City historical area shall be considered to be an extension of the school campus. This will not require parent permission forms as required in the field trip policy, but will require principal approval and may require parent prior notification or an approval form, if required by the principal.
