Title: Valedictorian Policy

VALEDICTORIAN POLICY

To qualify as a Valedictorian, Salutatorian or Historian at Virginia City High School, a student must:

1. Have completed at least 5 (five) semesters at Virginia City High School including all senior year requirements.
2. Complete a minimum of 4 (four) classes during both semesters of the student's last year. These may include college dual credit classes, but no correspondence courses.
3. Have the highest GPA or be tied for the highest GPA to be the Valedictorian.
4. Have the second highest GPA or be tied for the second highest GPA, to be Salutatorian.
5. Have the third highest GPA or be tied for the third highest GPA to be Class Historian.
6. Class speakers will be named by the class from the above students.
7. GPA's are computed by grades on the transcript as support by the grade books of teachers and may not be changed except by following NRS 392.025.
8. GPA's are to be rounded to the hundredth of a point (i.e. 3.45) and are computed as:

4.0	A/A+
3.8	A-
3.5	B+
3.0	B
2.8	B-

etc.
9. Only the original grade(s) will be used to select the valedictorian, salutatorian or historian. (Refer to IKH).
