**FINAL EXAMINATION POLICY**

The Board of School Trustees is committed to offering and maintaining academic programs of superior quality. The quality of an educational program can be determined by assessing the knowledge, skills and abilities of the students who are enrolled in the program.

It is the policy of the Board of School Trustees that for grades, 7-12, comprehensive semester examinations be administered at the conclusion of each semester in these subjects:

- English
- Mathematics
- Social Studies
- Science
- Foreign Language
- Occupational Education

Teachers of other subjects are encouraged to develop appropriate measures consistent with the spirit of this policy.

The final examination is to comprise no less than 20% of the student's semester grade nor more than 35%.

The final examination should measure the students' skills, knowledge or ability from the beginning of semester.

The final examination shall be at least 2 class periods in length.

The final examination is to be reviewed and approved by the site administrator.

Special Needs students may be excused from final examinations with an I.E.P. exclusion or by recommendation of the special ed teacher with principal concurrence.
